Dear Friends,



At one time in my life, I felt overwhelmed by the circumstances of life, and for many years, lived by the theme of an old Simon and Garfunkel song: “I am a rock. I am an island. And a rock feels no pain. And an island never cries.” It took a long while to realize that rocks and islands also lose hope and love and joy. We cannot be islands or rocks to avoid the tears. It is only when we fully engage ALL there is of life that we truly live. As John Donne said, “No man is an island.” We are deeply connected.

Parker J. Palmer said well what we must know as we enter the new year: “The deeper our faith, the more doubt we must endure; the deeper our hope, the more prone we are to despair; the deeper our love, the more pain its loss will bring; these are a few of the paradoxes we must endure as human beings. If we refuse to hold them in the hopes of living without doubt, despair, and pain, we also find ourselves living without faith, hope, and love.” (*A Hidden Wholeness: The Journey Toward an Undivided Life*)
